GET THE FACTS ON ISSUE 1

Will voting NO on Issue 1 deny women care for miscarriages or ectopic pregnancies?

NO. Ohio Code already differentiates between abortion and miscarriages and care for ectopic pregnancies.



Does Issue 1 prevent late-term abortions?

NO. A legal loophole in Issue 1 allows even a full-term baby to be aborted for any reason, at any time up until birth.



Does Issue 1 protect parent rights?

NO. All parental rights over their minor children's reproductive decisions, including consent and notification of a minor's abortion or gender reassignment, are considered "burdens" and removed.



Does Issue 1 protect women's health?

NO. Unlike other medical procedures, Issue 1 removes the requirement for an abortion provider to tell a woman of the dangers, risks, and hazards involved in having an abortion.



Will voting NO on Issue 1 make abortion illegal?

NO. Under current Ohio law, abortion is legal up to 22 weeks. If Issue 1 fails, this law and the laws protecting parental rights and a woman's health and safety stay in effect.
