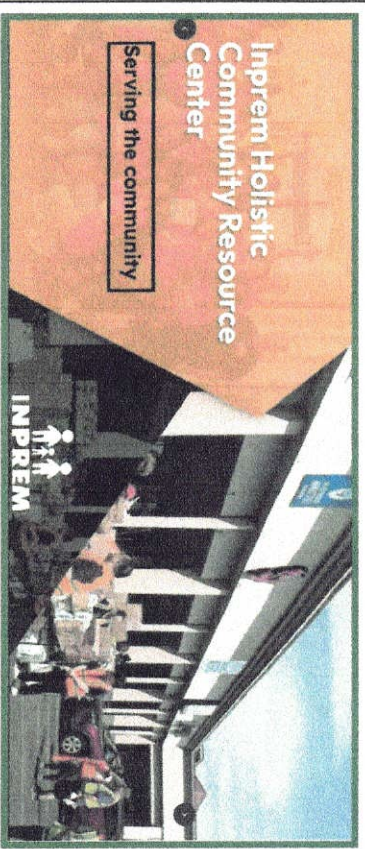

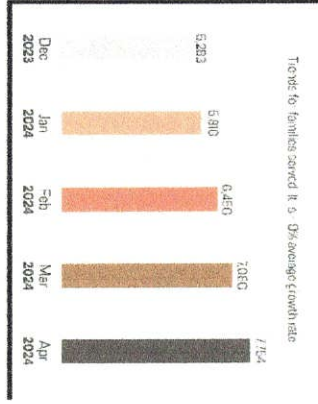

- Every household is entitled to service once a month





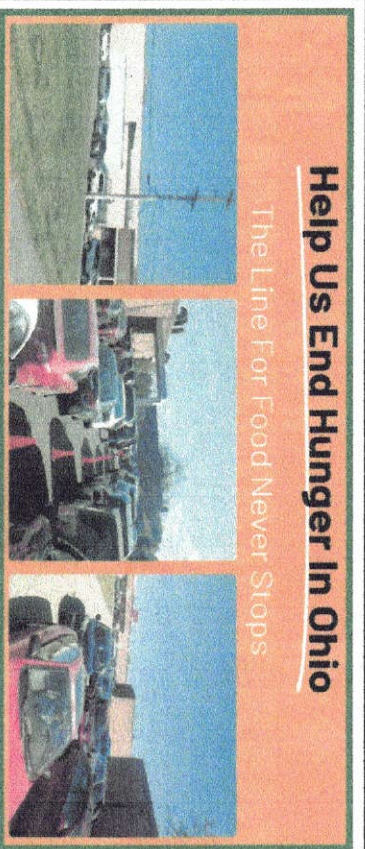
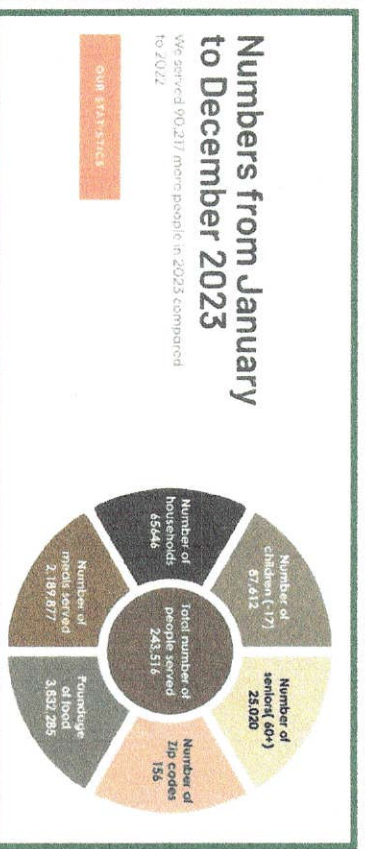
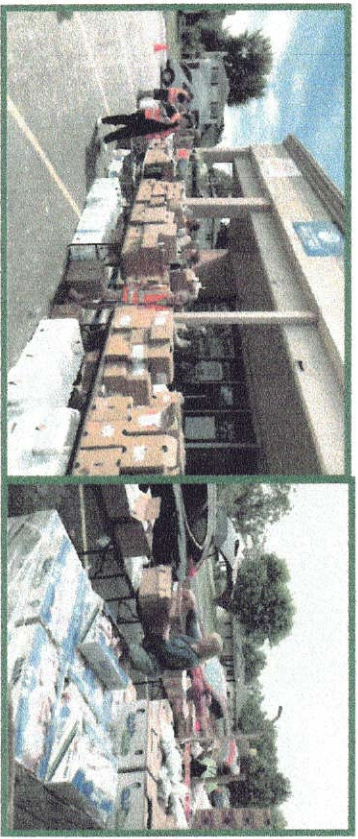

Brothers, I will ask you to please check that you have your rosary with you. You may find this annoying, as I do it every month, but I want to remind you that during your initiation ceremony, when you were presented with your rosary, you were prompted, "Carry this with you always and pray it as often as you can". With all the activity going on at our initiation ceremonies, it is hard to remember this, but given that we are in August and this month is traditionally dedicated to the sacred heart of Mary, I wanted to remind us all of this promise. There are several opportunities to get to a mass in honor of Mary this month. This Thursday we have the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary and we have several opportunities to get to masses this day. Next week Thursday is the Queenship of Mary and in September, on the 8<sup>th</sup> is the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Try to take advantage of these opportunities to grow your knowledge and relationship with our Holy patroness.

One other note of interest this month is that of the Perseid meteor showers, which culminate tonight. This is sometimes referred to as the Tears of St. Lawrence. If you recall, St. Lawrence was a deacon of Rome, martyred four days after the Pope Saint Sixtus II was martyred. Legend has it that Lawrence was charged with responsibility for the material goods of the church and the distribution of alms to the poor and when asked to provide all the material wealth of the church to Rome, he sold off all the material wealth the church had at the time and gave it to the poor. He presented the blind, lame and widows to the prefect and stated, "These are the treasure of the Church".

I wanted to try to follow a theme for these lectures this fraternal year and was thinking of discussing with you some of the heresy's of the Catholic Church, that we might better understand them. Since it is August, let's focus on six common heresy's around Mary.

1. **Ebionism** teaches many things, but with respect to Mary, they deny the Virgin birth, believing that Joseph is the natural father of Jesus and that Mary and Joseph conceived Jesus in the way that all parents conceive children. Ebionism was an early Jewish Christian movement that taught that Jesus was merely a mortal man with two human parents who reached the highest state of human sanctity and thereby received the honorific title of "son of God." Many liberal Protestant pastors and teachers now hold to this view.
2. **Helvidianism.** Helvidias taught that Mary was a virgin at Christ's birth, but after the birth of Christ, she and Saint Joseph engaged in marital relations and conceived a number of children. While the early Protestant Reformers affirmed the perpetual virginity of Mary, most subsequent Protestants hold the view of Helvidias.
3. **Valentinianism** taught that Holy Spirit *deposited* the Christ Child in her womb and that Mary was a surrogate mother, but not truly Christ's genetic mother. Valentinian the Gnostic (d. 160) taught that the Son of God passed through Mary like water through a straw. The Apostle Paul refutes this when he writes, "God sent His Son, made of a woman."
4. **Collyridianism** is the heresy that holds that Mary is a divine goddess worthy of the worship of adoration. The heresy was popular in pre-Islamic Arabia (AD 300s-500s) and it is likely the reason that the Arabic Quran wrongly assumes that the Christian Trinity is God, Jesus, Mary.
5. **Nestorianism** teaches that Jesus is two "persons." The archbishop Nestorius (yes, not all archbishops are orthodox) denied that Mary was the "Theotokos" or "Bearer of God" by saying that she was the mother only of

the "human Jesus" and not the "divine Jesus." On the contrary, the Catholic Church teaches that Christ is one person with two natures: divine nature and human nature. Hence Mary is the mother of the divine Person who is the Son of God. Logically, she is the Mother of He who is God the Son. She is the Mother of God, though not the Mother of the divine essence of the Trinity.
